

EXPORT – necessary documents

If the vehicle is purchased for someone else, the buyer must have an officially authenticated power of attorney in Czech, eventually in English or German language

All documents delivered by the buyer when purchasing a vehicle (power of attorney, statement of the Business Register etc. – others than identity documents), must be in Czech language, or eventually translated into English or German language.

1. Export within the EU (Company)

- Evidence of a valid VAT – VAT payer
- Trade License or a copy of Business Register, including Czech or English translation
- Valid document of the person acting on behalf of the Company – either identity card or passport
- Bank account details – SWIFT, IBAN, bank name and address

2. Export within the EU (Individual)

- Valid identity documents – either identity card or passport

3. Export outside the EU

- Valid identity document - passport
- Address where the vehicle will be exported to
- Border crossing where the vehicle will leave the EU
- Bank account details – SWIFT, IBAN, bank name and address
